

Welcome Young Miss Contestants!!

The girl who wins Young Miss Jo Daviess County Fair will be asked to participate with the Miss Jo Daviess County Fair Jr. Miss & Queen at Fair events during the weekend. She will also be invited to ride in parades with the Jr. Miss & Queen and attend certain festivals & activities throughout the year to promote the pageant.

There is a \$30 Sponsor Fee that is due at the first practice along with the application and all forms. Sponsor Fee can be one or two different sponsors. This fee will go towards costs to cover sashes and the Young Miss Tiara. There will be a \$10 late fee for any application or sponsor fee turned in AFTER July 12th.

Girls will be competing for the title of Young Miss Jo Daviess County Fair. We will have a 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up and Miss Personality. Each winner will receive a sash, flowers, and gift bags.

Interview:

Each contestant will partake in a 2 minute interview with the 3 judges. No reason to worry, we will have mock interviews at the practices to prepare for this portion. This portion is for the judges to learn a little more about each of you girls in a one on one setting. You will need to wear your Sunday best skirt or dress, with a button down cardigan and closed toed shoes. Look professional but remember you are 9-11 years of age. Minimal makeup is allowed, but don't cake it on, these judges will see your natural beauty.

Pageant:

The Young Miss Contestants will start the night off with introductions and answering two on stage questions. They will next perform a non-judged dance routine and then compete in an Evening gown competition. Evening gowns must be floor length. No cut outs or poofy dresses will be allowed. There must be no cleavage shown. All dresses must be approved by the Director. There is **NOT** a swimsuit portion to this competition.

Evening Gown Competition

Stage Presence portion of the competition. Judges look for facial beauty, grace & poise.

Communication Skills

Each contestant introduces themselves on stage, followed by a statement of what they want to be when they grow up. Judges look for how well the girls present their answers and the confidence they show.

Judges will observe how each contestant shows enthusiasm throughout the entire night.

The Young Miss will be assisting the Queen & Jr. Miss in promoting the County fair, Jo Daviess County & Agriculture, how she relates to her crowd is very important.

Queens Required 7hrs/Quarter = 28 Hours Total
